You know what has happened throughout Judea, beginning in Galilee after the baptism that John preached—how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power and how he went around doing good and healing all who were under the power of the devil, because God was with him. Acts 10:38 (NIV)

- 4. Jesus is the One who was _____.**
*We are witnesses of everything he did in the country of the Jews and in Jerusalem. They killed him by hanging him on a tree.

*He commanded us to preach to the people and to testify that he is the one whom God appointed as judge of the living and the dead.
Acts 10:42 (NIV)*
- 7. Jesus is the One through whom we receive God's _____ for our _____.**
All the prophets testify about him that everyone who believes in him receives forgiveness of sins through his name. Acts 10:43 (NIV)
